The Ministry of Social Solidarity (MOSS) has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Strengthening Social Safety Net Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services (“the Services”) include design, development and operationalization of a comprehensive Management Information System (MIS). The consulting services implementation is expected to commence on the 2nd quarter of year 2022. The implementation duration for system design, development and handover will be Ten (10) months, followed by two years of maintenance and technical support services.

The Ministry of Social Solidarity (MOSS) now invites eligible consulting firms (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criteria are as follows:

1. Minimum average annual turnover of USD 500,000 as shall be demonstrated through submitted audited financial statements for fiscal years 2018, 2019 & 2020.
2. At least five (5) years of experience in similar assignments.
3. Must have successfully designed and developed during the last five (5) years at least two (2) MIS project, preferably in the areas of social protection, health, education, human resources management, social insurance, pensions, or similar sectors. Operational acceptance certification, certification letter or any relevant supporting documents should be submitted.
4. Must have prior work experience working with the Government of Egypt in the ICT sector.
5. Strong and proven records in similar assignments and capable of demonstrating sufficient technical and managerial capabilities to undertake the execution of the Services.



The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to Section III, paragraphs, 3.14, 3.16, and 3.17 of the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" July 2016, setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest. A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method set out in the Procurement Regulations.
