- Promote collaboration and networking among key personnel in rural development and poverty alleviation from participating countries.

As the programme is specialized and technical, AARDO will accept only nomination(s) of candidates who are relevant to the subject of the programme, based on their qualification and experience. Prospective nominee(s) must satisfy the following:

Essential Qualifications:

- Minimum a bachelor's degree in the Relevant Field, with considerable working experience in planning and executing the programmes related to subject of the programme.
- Must be subject specialist and related to the subject of the programme.
- Proficiency in spoken and written English language, as the medium of conducting the programme is English only and translation facilities into any other language would not be available.
- Preferably below 55 (fifty-five) years of age.
- No participation in AARDO's offline programme over the last two years.
- Must be in good health to undergo the programme.

It is worth mentioning that as AARDO's policy is to serve a maximum number of participants from member countries, the nominations of candidates who have attended any technical programme in offline mode over the last two years will not be considered. 


COURSE OBJECTIVE

QUALIFICATION & REQUIREMENTS

The course is ideally suited for:

- · Middle and senior-level government officials;
- Policy and programme planner and implementers who are responsible for rural/ agricultural development programme;
- Those nominated or appointed by their government;
- Those within the age of 25 55 years old, with no participation in any AARDO's offline training programme over the preceding two years; Proficiency in spoken and written English;
- · Valid passport (6 months before expiring date of travel); and
- . In good health both physically and mentally with a certified medical
- · acknowledgement that allows them to complete this course.

IMPORTANT

All applicants must provide a valid email address written/printed legibly in the application form. Confirmation of the course and other notifications will be made using email.



APPLICATION

PROCESS

Step 2 : Fill up the details and submit. Take print out of the filled in application form.

Step 3: Applicants are required to sign their applications and send them along with the recommendation letter of the Nodal Ministry of AARDO/ Centre of



- . The participants of the training programme will be finalized by AARDO and INFRA through selection meeting.
- Only successful applicants will receive the Official Invitation notification one (1) month from the course date, by the training institute via email.
- . WhatsApp Group will be formed to facilitate communication between the selected participants and the organizers.



VISA & VACCINATION

All participants are compulsory to enter Malaysia with Visa With Reference (VWR). Participants selected for the programme will receive a copy of the approval from the Institute. With the copy of the approval, the participants may obtain the VWR from the nearest Malaysian missions. Wherever applicable, participants are advised to arrange on their own any necessary vaccination prior to travel to Malaysia. Participants from some countries are required to take a mandatory vaccination for yellow fever at least 10 days before their departure to Malaysia. A Yellow Fever certificate is required to be produced upon landing in Malaysia. All expenses for the purpose of obtaining the visa and or vaccination are under the responsibility of the respective participants.



FELLOWSHIP & SCHOLARSHIP

Participants will receive support from the Government of Malaysia includes:

ACCOMMODATION

Participants will be accommodated in the hostel or at the nearby hotels. Participants are strictly not allowed to bring any family members during the course.

PER DIEM ALLOWANCE

Participants will be provided with a daily allowance.

MEALS

Meals will be provided during the training programe.

AIR FARES

A return flight ticket from the capital city of the recipient country to Kuala Lumpur on economy class is provided by AARDO.

COURSE FEES

All course fees are borne by the Government of Malaysia and AARDO except Visa Expenses.

ATTIRE

Participants are to dress in formal or office attire throughout training sessions and during official visits to Government Ministries/ Agencies.

INSURANCE COVERAGE

Travel Group Insurance is provided by the organizer for the duration of the course in Malaysia. However, participants are encouraged to obtain travel insurance coverage from their respective countries at their own expense.
